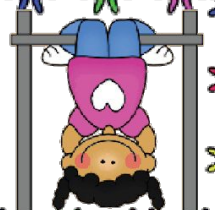
- Best Khaki Bottoms (pants or skirt)

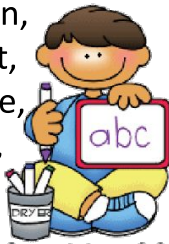

**Grammar:** punctuation, special adjectives, capitalization, colons, commas, subject/verb agreement

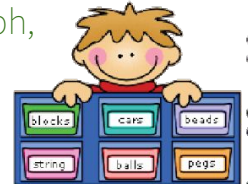
**Writing:** Fantasy
