Spelling/Phonics: /oo/ spelled oo, Comparative Ending -er, Superlative Ending -est, Irregular Comparatives

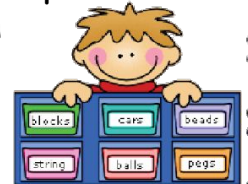
Math: Chapter 14 - Money (We will continue to practice subtraction with regrouping.)
