## Formal Uniform Guidelines

Formal uniform items should be clean, neat, in good repair, and without adornments. All clothing should reflect good taste and have a modest fit with no visible undergarments. Shirts are to remain tucked during school hours. For skirts/jumpers lengths, see specific grade guidelines below. Any requests for modification to uniform requirements must be approved in advance by the Head of school, Division Director or Dean of Student Affairs.

## Grades 1-4

## Girls

- Cardigan - (October-March) Navy or red fine -gauge, cardigan with logo and no pockets
- Jumper - Plaid with solid white long-sleeve or short-sleeve collared dress shirt. jumpers must come down PAST the child's fingertips when their arms are down at their sides
- Skirt/Skort- Plaid A-line or pleated, no more than 3" above the knee. Skort style must have skirt panel in front and back.
- Shirt -(October-March) - Solid white, longsleeve, three-quarter sleeve, or short-sleeve, collared dress shirt with cardigan; (warmer weather) red or navy polo with logo
- Socks/Tights - Solid white or navy tights, bobby socks, or knee-high socks; no anklets, no leggings.
- Shoes - Flat, closed-toe and closed-heel leather dress shoes; black, brown, or navy.


## Boys

- Vest - (October-March) Navy or red cotton sweater vest with logo
- Pants - Khaki (no shorts)
- Shirt - (October-March); Solid white, longsleeve or short-sleeve, collared dress shirt with vest; (warmer weather) navy or red polo with logo
- Belt - Black or brown leather dress belt
- Socks - Solid black, brown, navy, or khaki
- Shoes - Black or brown leather dress shoes


## Grades 5-12

## Girls

- Cardigan - (October-March) Navy, finegauge, cardigan with logo and no pockets
- Skirt/Skort- Plaid A-line or pleated, no more than 3" above the knee. Skort style must have skirt panel in front and back.
- Jumper - (Grades 5-8) Plaid with solid white long-sleeve or short-sleeve collared dress shirt. Jumpers must be no more than 3 " above the knee.
- Shirt - Solid white, long-sleeve, three-quarter sleeve, or short-sleeve, collared dress shirt
- Socks/Tights - Socks are optional. Solid white or navy tights or knee-high socks; nude hosiery is optional; no anklets allowed
- Shoes - Flat, closed-toe and closed-heel leather dress shoes; black, brown, or navy.


## Boys

- Blazer - (October-March) Solid navy with no adornments
- Pants - Khaki dress slacks (no shorts / no cargo)
- Shirt - Solid white, long-sleeve or shortsleeve, collared dress shirt
- Tie - Mead Hall ties or bowties (available in Mead Hall Episcopal School's Store only)
- Belt - Black or brown leather dress belt
- Socks - Solid black, brown, navy, or khaki
- Shoes - Black or brown leather dress shoes
