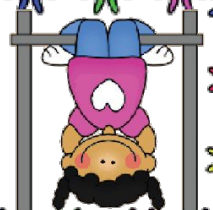


I know the holidays are approaching quickly and many of us are already making plans. Please let me know ahead of time if your child will not be at school so that we can make arrangements to continue their learning.

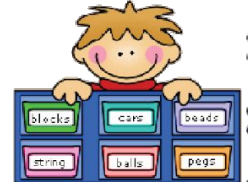
