The holidays are approaching quickly and many of us are making travel plans. Please let me know ahead of time if your child will not be here so that we can make arrangements to continue their learning.

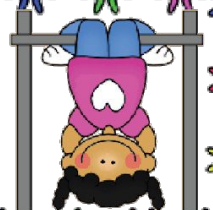


Classroom/School News:
