Classroom/School News:

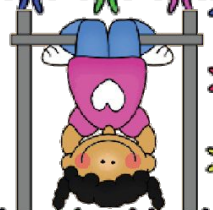

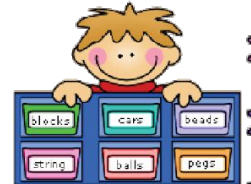
