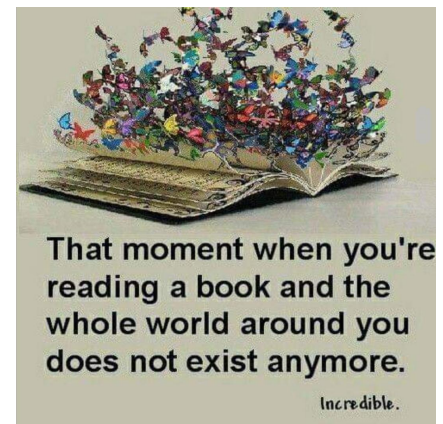
You all did an amazing job!!!

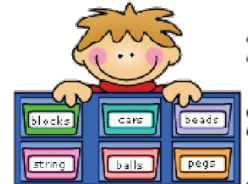
