Spelling/Phonics: /n/ and /r/ sounds; -er, -est endings

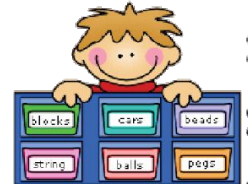
High Frequency Words: another, away, many, how, sign, where, now, could, uncle, write, would, saw, about, are, know, me, my, too
