

Lower School Uniform Guidelines

Daily Uniform

Girls

- **Polo Shirts** White, red, or navy (logo required on red and navy polos)
- Turtlenecks White, red, or navy (logo required on red and navy turtlenecks)
- Pants or Shorts Khaki twills or chinos only (no leggings, cargo, yoga, or riding pants)
- Dresses or Skirts Red or navy polo dress with logo, khaki or "Mead Hall plaid" jumper or skirt
- Belts Solid black, brown, navy, red, or khaki belt if bottoms have belt loops (1st-12th grade)
- Socks or Tights- Solid navy, white or red
- **Leggings** Only when worn underneath a skirt or dress; solid navy or red
- Shoes Sneakers in solid white, black, brown, khaki, red, or navy or flat closed-toe and closed-heel shoes in solid black, brown, red, or navy. No light-ups or embellishments, no high-tops, and no boots (Exception: Rain boots may be worn ONLY on rainy days).
- **Hair** Should be neat, clean, well-groomed, of a natural color and style, and should be styled out of the face with simple, complimentary accessories.
- Accessories Unobtrusive earrings, Necklaces, and bracelets that are complimentary to the uniform can be worn.

Boys

- **Polo Shirts** White, red, or navy (logo required on red and navy polos)
- Turtlenecks White, red, or navy (logo required on red and navy turtlenecks)
- Pants and Shorts Khaki twills or chinos
- **Belts** Solid black, brown, navy, or khaki belt if bottoms have belt loops (1st-12th grade)
- Socks Solid navy, white, black, brown or khaki
- Shoes Sneakers in solid white, black, brown, khaki, red, or navy or flat closed-toe and closed-heel shoes in solid black, brown, or navy. No light-ups or embellishments, no high-tops, and no boots (Exception: Rain boots may be worn ONLY on rainy days).
- Hair should be neat, clean, well-groomed, of a natural color and style, and should not obscure facial features or extend below the collar. Face should be clean-shaven.
- Accessories No earrings may be worn.

All uniform items should be clean, neat, in good repair, and without adornments. All clothing items should reflect good taste and modest fit. Shirts are to remain tucked during school hours. All pants, shorts, skirts, and skorts are to be worn at the waist or slightly below. All dresses, shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers must come down PAST the child's fingertips when their arms are down at their sides.

Dress Down Days

The daily uniform requirements for fit and length apply to pants, jeans, cargos, capris, shorts, skirts, skorts, dresses, and jumpers. Tank tops, spaghetti straps, or halter tops are not allowed. Leggings are not allowed unless worn under a skirt, dress or tunic top that meets daily uniform length requirements. Clothing may not bear inappropriate graphics or profanity. Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes or sneakers are required.

Outerwear (worn inside building)

- Red or navy (with logo) sweaters, fleece vests, fleece jackets, sweat shirts, or hoodies.
- The only athletic hoodie allowed is the navy with panther logo available through the Booster Club.
- Coats without logo, boots, hats, hoods, scarves, and sunglasses may not be worn inside.
