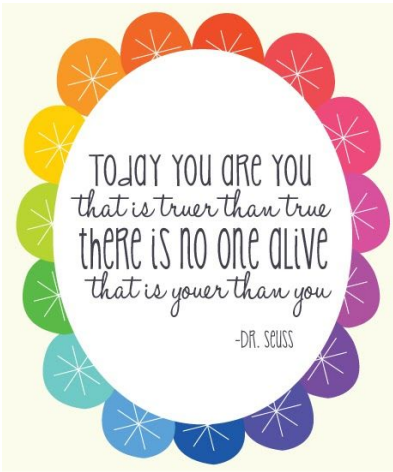


Wednesday - May 6, 2020
